0210 7/9/08 This RN in charge and was called to the patient's room by pt's nurse. Mom upset and refused for to give our Tegretol (Carbamazepine) medication from our pharmacy because it was orange <sup>orange</sup> and her medication from home is white. Explained to mom that our Tegretol is orange and it's from a different manufacturer. Pt's home med from Kuwait. Mom stated she gave her home medication and has been giving her home medication since admission. This RN noted no orders <sup>on 7/9/08</sup> stating that home meds OK to be given. Mom refused to allow me to lock up her home medication in our narc cabinet. Mom appears upset + crying. Mom noted to not be <sup>any more</sup> getting a lot of sleep. When this RN asked mom how much of her home medication she gave she showed me the syringe and stated "10ml + 2 ml" which

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she stated ~~was~~ 250mg. Mom appeared to be aware of ~~the~~ <sup>mom 7/9/08</sup> increase from 200mg to 250mg BID on 7/8/08, yesterday. Mom was escalating and becoming more angry as I tried to explain things and understand her concerns. At this time I felt that leaving mom alone and allowing her to rest would be best. This issue ~~will~~ <sup>mom 7/9/08</sup> will be passed on to the medical + nursing team in the AM to be resolved. — *Kristin Marnick*

7/9/08 0230 Pt's RN called pharmacy to clarify what dose pt's mother gave pt per home supply. Pt's home supply bottle of Tegretol read 2% which per pharmacy means 2gm/100mL (the same concentration as JHH pharmacy tegretol 20mg/mL). Mom stated that she had given "10mL + 2mL" so mom gave pt 240mg, not 250mg. Patient of care pharmacist and medical team need to address this with mom and decide whether to allow home ~~dose~~ <sup>medication</sup> to be given. This RN will pass on to team in the AM. Pt is no seizure activity since 7/8/08 0400. Pt asleep + calm at this time. — *Kristin Marnick*

Social Work/ Care Coordination Consultation:

On 07/08/08 SW met with Haya's parents (Mr. Al-Yasin and Mrs. Al-Buloushi) to orient them to role of SW and to rehab process. SW informed them of family conference scheduled for 07/09/08 at 4:30pm. Both parents plan to attend. SW confirmed that JHH patient coordinator, Sally, will be able to attend.

Haya lives with her parents and two sisters in Kuwait. Her family is renting a home in Annapolis and has a car for transportation. They have traveled extensively to access medical care for Haya. Mr. Al-Yasin works in retail and noted that he is managing finances well while being away from home. Their goals for admission are for Haya's "seizures to be solved" and the "right doctors" to be invested in assessing Haya's needs. Their secondary goal is for Haya to access therapies, which Mr. Al-Yasin expressed will be possible once Haya is "seizure free." He noted that it is critical to find a "solution" and that he is open to new technologies and willing to "go anywhere." Supports to the family include a grandmother and nanny that are with the family during this stay. Stressors reported relate to the family's desire to have a private room. Haya's parents acknowledge that their journey to find a cure for Haya has been challenging, but they present as highly dedicated to help Haya reach her maximum potential. Mr. Al-Yasin acknowledged the impact that Haya's medical condition has had on their family, especially Haya's sisters.
