CONSULTANT'S FINDINGS

CONSULTATION DATE:

Haya is a 5 year 1 month old ♀ who was admitted to KKI on 7/7/08. In brief, she was a typically developing child - walking by 14 mos (though she was unsteady & had an abnormal gait). She was counting, called her sister by names, could repeat words or songs. She would point to objects. She would finger feed. She had an adenoidectomy in 2005, after which she developed a rapidly progressive deterioration in her skills. She was soon unable to walk, could not support herself, stopped talking. Rett's test and other labs were negative per parents. She developed projectile emesis and went to Germany. There, she was diagnosed w/ pilocytic astrocytoma which was resected 9/05. Hydrocephalus persisted requiring frequent imaging & LPs. VP shunt was placed 1/06. After the resection / shunt, she has had gradual but steady gain of skills (improved head & body control, babbling). She underwent outpt PT & SLP between 2006-2008 without further complications. However, in Jan 2008, she developed sz.

Seizure history: 1st occurred 1/2/08: right eye deviation + twitching, foaming, no response, bil GTC, ⊕ apnea + perioral + distal (fingers) cyanosis. This lasted 20 min. Required BMV/CPR. A second occurred shortly thereafter in CT scan, same appearance, lasting 5 min. She was given load IV phenytoin & admitted. She was discharged home on 8 ml of Tegretol. Her sz occurred every 7-12 days, with occasional clusters. Most recently, she was having a sz every 7 days until 6/14-7/7/08 during which she was sz. free. On admission to KKI 7/7/08, she had a sz: eyes open, cyanotic, apnea, tonic mvmts requiring O₂. Yday she had a 10 min sz requiring Diastad @ 5 min. Tegretol was ↑ed yday from 200 to 250 mg BID (level low @ 5.8).

In addition to this significant sz history, Haya also developed "irritability" which started @ the same time as the sz/Tegretol. She will cry/fuss/and seem in pain for ~ 3 days/week. She cannot communicate if something in particular hurts. Per parents, shunt malfnctn was ruled out & imaging stable. Parents also note GI evaluated her. She does, however, burp a lot during this time period. She has never had a pH probe or tx for reflux per parents.
